



ADMISSION PROCESS



1. ADMISSION:

The minimum age for admission in Nursery is Three and a Half years. Age for admission to other classes is correspondingly. At present classes run from Nursery to XII. The medium of teaching language is English. The School follows the syllabus and Session of Central board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.) New Delhi.

2. REGISTRATION:

Registration Form and Prospectus will be available in the School office from 1st December on Payment of Rs.

500/- (Five Hundred Rupees Only) in Cash. The cost of prospectus and registration fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances. At the time of Admission the birth certificate (online), transfer certificate (T.C) with one passport size photograph, Aadhar Card of the Student, Father & Mother is to be submitted in the school.

One Passport size photograph of father and mother along with the admission form. Medical Fitness Certificate of Student. One photograph of that person who will come to meet his/her ward.

18. CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

4. You can not take any edible items like dry fruits, snacks, fast food any type of soft drinks from your parents/guardians (Specifically for Hostellers).

19. MEDICAL:

In case of illness, medical treatment is managed by the school management and the expenses incurred in this process are charged from the parents later.

20. MODE OF PAYMENT:

22. GENERAL INSTRUCTION TO THE PARENTS:

1. Parents are advised to send their wards to school in proper uniform. No student will be allowed to join the class, if he/she is not in proper uniform.
2. Parents are requested to pay charge for excursion, picnic etc.
3. Parents are also requested to contact the principal regarding the progress of the wards living in school-hostel to discuss any academic problem and it's possible solution.
4. Parents are requested to take part in "parents-teachers" meet and make the meet affirmative.





23. IMPORTANT NOTES.

1. All parents/guardians may please note that the contingency as given in the prospectus are liable to change with or without prior notice by the school administration depending upon administrative successful contingencies or exigencies arising at any time.
2. Clarification, if any, given by the school way of interpretation to the various clauses contained in the prospectus shall be tenable at medininagar court only.

24. GENERAL SCHOOL RULES

1. Every student must reach school fifteen minutes prior to morning assembly.
2. Students who are escorted to and from school in the care of servants of other domestic staff may not leave the school premises without their nominated escort. In case of delay in the arrival of such escorts, they should report the matter to the school office. Students who go home at their own should not loiter about on the way.
3. The school reserves the right to terminate the continuance of the students with unsatisfactory progress in studies or whose conduct is a bad example for others.
4. Bullying or uses of foul language are punishable offences. Anyone found doing the same is liable to be issued Yellow/Red card which subsequently will result in expulsion from school.
5. In the interest of their own safety, students are advised not to buy or receive any gifts/food stuffs from anyone at all in route.
6. Students are forbidden to buy any eatables from hawkers outside the school.



7. The school is committed to protect the environment and expects its students to be environment friendly in all their actions.
8. Students are not allowed to celebrate their birthday at school. They are permitted to come to school in casual dress.
9. No student has the permission to commute to school on his/her self-driven geared two wheeler without a driving license.
10. Applying henna on hands/nail polish on nails, getting tattoos carved, bleaching hair is strictly prohibited.
11. Students can't leave school campus on any pretext during school hours except in emergency with prior permission of the principal.
12. It is mandatory for all students, unless instructed otherwise, to be present for festivals and functions celebrated in the school campus, failing which they will be charged ₹20 per absence.

25. WITHDRAWALS:

1. Withdrawals from any class must be preceded by a written notice or clearing all the dues before a month in lieu of notice.
2. All dues will have to be cleared before a transfer certificate is issued.
3. Transfer certificate will be issued after two days of receiving the application.
4. A fee of Rs. 1000/- will be charged for issuing a duplicate copy of the transfer certificate and the parents will have to submit an affidavit alongwith original copy of News Paper Column (missing report) about the loss of the original certificate.
